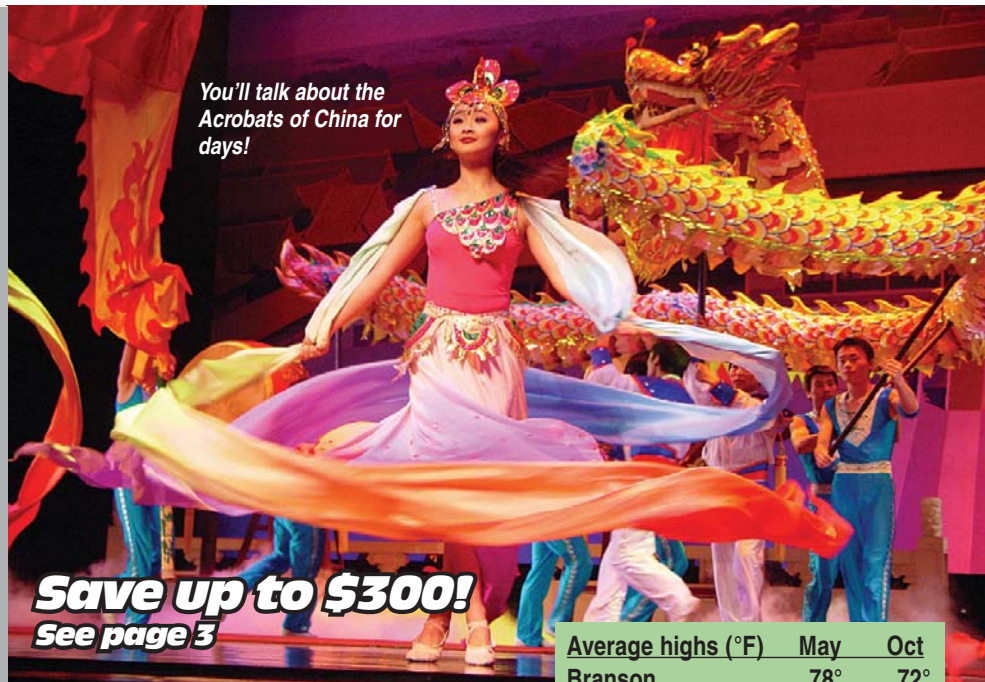

11-day Description

Day 1 Excitement runs high as we meet those with whom we will share the next 11 fun-filled days at the Live Music Capital of the World. We also meet our guide, a life-long resident of Branson, who will provide priceless insights into the history and culture of this extraordinary Ozark community.

Day 2 The adventure begins non-stop as we experience the fascinating legacy of the King of Cowboys and the Queen of the West at the Roy Rogers and Dale Evans Museum, followed by the music that made them famous at their Happy Trails Theater. After our Tracks lunch we're whisked to the heart of the entertainment district and Branson's very first show, the Baldknobbers Jamboree. You'll know what started Branson Fever as you roar with laughter during the hilarious skits and great country music!

Day 3 Our excitement escalates at The Doug Gabriel Show, with Doug playing the "mufftar"—a guitar made from the muffler of a '69 Ford! Our fun tour of Branson reveals the town's special appeal where the locals shop at Dick's 5 and Dime stocked with everything from washboards to wire corn poppers. We also peek at some stars' homes like those of Charlie Pride and Andy Williams.

An elaborate dinner at The Grand Plaza Hotel prepares us for an evening of "Rock the House" gospel, patriotic medleys, and good-natured humor at The Pierce Arrow Show.

Day 4 Today, it's Silver Dollar City—named one of the top theme parks in the world by the International Association of Amusement Parks. Besides five

roller coasters, there are steam-powered tractors, home-cooked food at a dozen family restaurants, barrel-making, horseshoeing, funnel cakes, saloons with dancing girls, sarsaparilla, and dazzling shows of world-renowned entertainment running all day into the night.

Day 5 Tour Hard Work University where, instead of paying tuition, many students work producing scrumptious gourmet creations from fruitcake to jams and jellies, all available at their bakery. At the Edward Grist Mill watch wheat being ground to flour with power from a 12-foot water wheel!

After lunch we enter the most elaborately decorated theater in Branson (complete with unbelievably elegant restrooms) and its greatest musical extravaganza, that of Shoji Tabuchi, where you'll find yourself almost overwhelmed by his wizardry, riveted to your seat, toe-tapping and swaying to a glorious repertoire ranging from American country ... to his native Japanese ... to classical music. Some say Shoji alone is worth the price of the entire Branson program!

Day 6 We dine and watch Alan Edwards, a great singer who mixes lots of comedy with happy audience participation.

In the evening, join an admiring crowd to hear the ever-popular Jim Stafford and his famous guitar-playing and comedy routine.

Day 7 Yakov Smirnoff came here from Russia not speaking any English, but his great love of the US (What a country!) made him welcome even at the White House. You'll be enthralled as Yakov's awesome Neva Russian Dance Ensemble leaps and twirls across the stage in brilliant native costuming.

In the evening, it's Mickey

Gilley's amazing mastery of honky tonk piano as he plays and sings favorites like, "I'm Sending You a Big Bouquet of Roses."

Day 8 This morning find out why the Hughes Brothers were voted Branson's best vocal group as you marvel at a Mormon family of more than 20 members from adults to tiny children all performing on stage.

We enjoy free time until our late-afternoon boarding of the Branson Belle Showboat. There's time to go out on deck to view Lake Taneycomo and the giant paddlewheel of our 278 foot cruiser before sitting down to a scrumptious dinner and a colorful vaudeville show.

Day 9 Next Jim Owen's moving, sentimental music takes on a melancholy, journey back to the time of Hank Williams. Our morning is topped off with ribs, chicken, and peach cobbler at historic Mickey Gilley's Texas Café—mmmmm!
